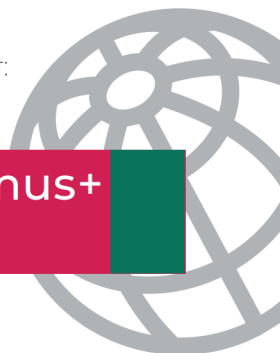

- Application Form;
 - Learning Agreement (accepted by the home and host university);
 - Transcript of Records (stamped by home university);
 - Copy of passport or national ID;
 - Copy of Certificate of Language Competence (English B2)*
 - Copy of Health Insurance is compulsory (can be delivered after deadline);
- *level B2 (sending University decides which certificate is applicable);

Most of the courses should be taken from the faculty you are enrolled at, but a few courses from other faculties are also possible
