6. Accommodation Information

Student housing is run by the student welfare organisation Sit. In Aalesund, most exchange students stay at Sørnesvågen studentboliger, which is located at the campus area, only a 5 minutes' walk from the campus main buildings. You can also choose to stay at Sundebygget which is located on campus. Monthly rent starts from approx. NOK 4200,- . Prices are adjusted annually.

Note: Exchange students need a special code from SiT before applying for housing, to be received normally after the admission letter.

7. Student Visa or Student Residence Permit

Non EU/EEA citizens must have a visa granted prior to coming to Norway.

All EU/EEA/Swiss citizens staying over 3 months must register with the Norwegian immigration authorities. Special regulations apply for citizens from the Nordic countries.
